

Barney Oldfield Louis Chevrolet To Race at Dayton



Barney Oldfield, master driver of the world, and Louis Chevrolet, idol of the speedways, are to meet at Dayton on Saturday, September 29, in a three-heat match race for a \$5,000 purse and the world's dirt track championship.

Oldfield contends that a newsboy can drive a racing car over the banked board tracks but that it requires skill and daring to an amazing degree to drive the 120-mile-an-hour racing cars around a one-half mile dirt track. He challenged the world a few days ago, and Chevrolet accepted the defi. A Dayton promoter hung up a \$5,000 purse, and the match is on. Oldfield will drive his Golden Submarine car, while Chevrolet will pilot his Frontenac, the same car with which he won the Cincinnati Speedway Memorial day race. The race starts at 3 o'clock.
