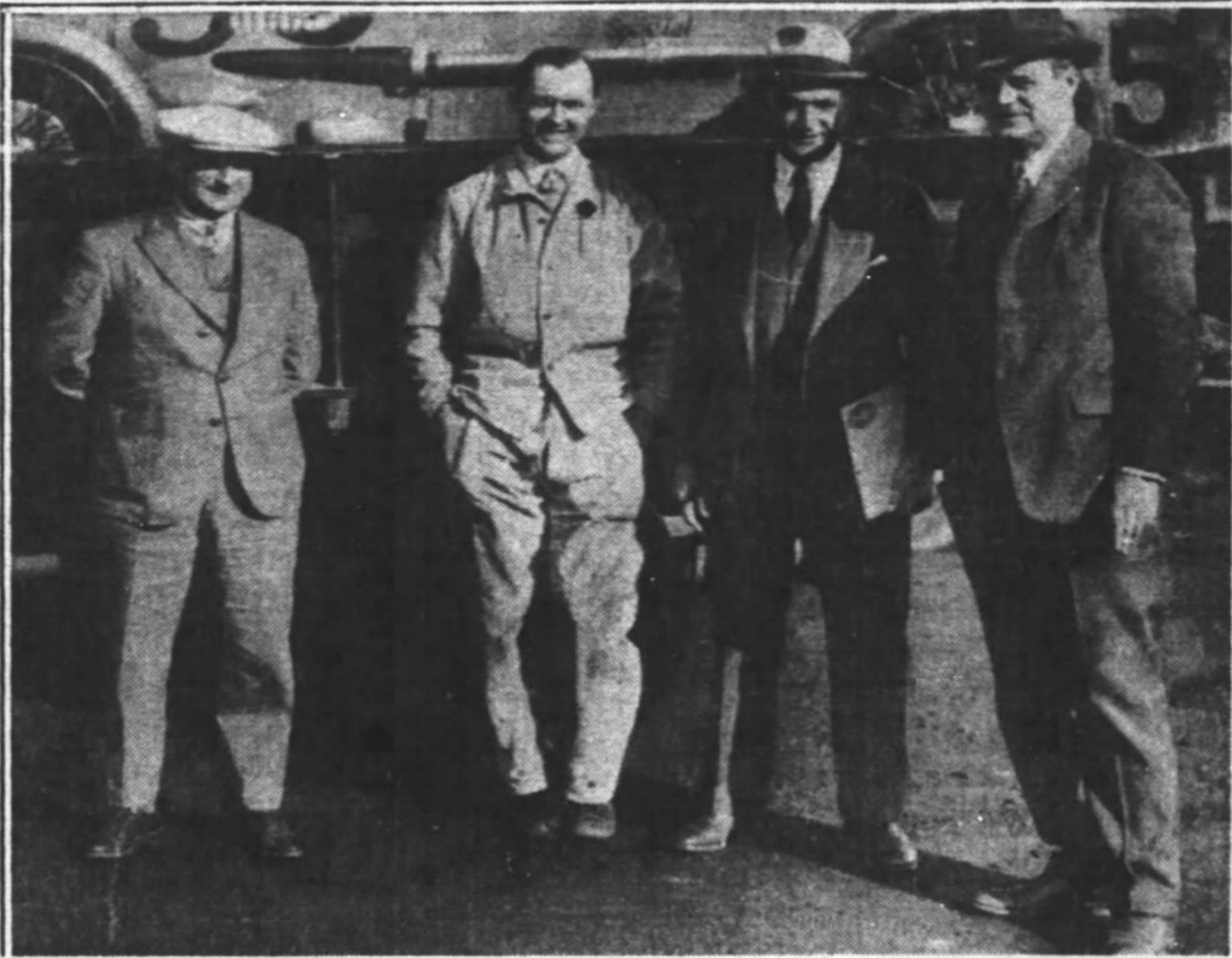


COSMOPOLITAN GROUP AT SPEEDWAY

The day Jules Moriceau arrived at the Indianapolis motor speedway with the Thompson Valve Special, which he will drive in the race, he was greeted by a fellow-countryman, Louis Chiron, and two other famous racing drivers. One of these, Ralph DePalma, born in America with an Italian name, won the race in 1915. Louis Chevrolet, an Americanized Swiss, built the 1920 and the 1921 winners which his brother Gaston and Tom Milton drove. Ten years ago Louis was a terror on the race track. Chiron, who will drive a Delage, was European champion in 1928.
