
AMENDED COMPLAINT IN THE ROOS DAMAGE SUIT

An amended complaint in the case of Dortha Roos, of this city, against the Buick Motor Car company for \$5,000 damages will be filed in the United States court at Indianapolis to-day by her attorney, William Fruechtenicht, and an early settlement of the case is anticipated.

Mrs. Roos was injured while seated in an automobile watching the 1910 Vanderbilt cup race in New York state. A Buick racer, driven by Louis Chevrolet left the course and crashed into her car, causing her to sustain injuries from which she has never fully recovered. When Mrs. Roos awoke in a hospital on the morning after the accident she found that her hair had turned white from the shock and horror of the crash.
