**CATONE TO FLY
ITALIAN COLORS
ON AKRON TRACK**

AKRON, Ohio, April 24—Joe Catone noted foreign pilot will carry the tri-colors of Italy in the 100 mile Rubber City Sweepstakes at the Akron-Cleveland Board Speedway on Sunday, May 5.

Called into conference at Indianapolis by Arthur Chevrolet, genius on racing motors and dean of automotive engineering, Catone was awarded the private mount of the veteran builder of Frontenac racing cars for its initial appearance in Akron.

This \$10,000 highly developed speed creation reputed to be the last word in motor construction, embodies more late appliances for speed production than yet shown in the east.

Determined to end the coming spring classic with a Frontenac victory in the hands of a thoroughly confident driver, Catone was selected by the famous french engineer to produce the maximum speed necessary to combat their many racing
