

# FAST BUICK BEING BUILT FOR RACING

## Louis Chevrolet Is Superintending Construction of Special Type Stock Car

Louis Chevrolet, famous throughout the motoring world as a race driver, is visiting the Philadelphia branch of the Buick motor company. He is superintending the making of certain parts of a new Buick model, with which he expects to make phenomenal speed in the stock car events of the coming competitive season.

Beyond stating that the new car would have a 4 cylinder motor with 6 inch bore and 5½ inch stroke, which would give the machine a rating of 60 horsepower, Chevrolet was noncommittal on the details of the newcomer, which report has it is expected to develop 100 horsepower.

"Bob Burman and I will bear the brunt of the races, driving for the Buick company this year," he said, "and I will have a string of cars in readiness for the Atlanta, Ga., meet early in May. I am superintending the building of the stock car which we will handle, and that they will be truly stock cars in every detail, with the exception of the racing wheel, will be proved by the fact that they will be for sale at the catalogued price at all times."
